Scholarship Selection and Evaluation Process

Scholarships are awarded on a yearly basis based on academic achievement, financial need, and community service. Please complete the scholarship application and provide all required documentation. Because the information that you provide on the application will be used to determine your eligibility for the scholarship, it is important you complete the application in its entirety. The applications are evaluated based on financial need, community service, grade point average, and the answers to the essay questions. Please type or print the application legibly and neatly.

Availability of Funds

Scholarship awards are subject to the availability of funds. Scholarships up to \$1,000 may be awarded to PHHS, AHS, and JSB and will be for freshman year only. Scholarships awarded to HHS may be renewable for three additional years of study if student is making satisfactory academic progress. All financial assistance will be taken into consideration when awarding scholarships so that the Justin Foundation may assist as many students as possible.

Qualifications to Apply for a Justin Scholarship

- Be a graduate of HHS, JSB, AHS, or PHHS
- Demonstrate Financial Need (EFC of less than 7000).
- Documented Community Service while a student in High School.
- Possess a 2.25 minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA).
- Complete the Justin Scholarship application, the FAFSA, and provide all required documentation.

Required Documentation (must be submitted by the scholarship deadline of 13 April 2018)

- Completed and signed application.
- An official copy of your high school transcript.
