

Washington County Farm Bureau
SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

1. The Washington County Farm Bureau Board of Directors will appoint a Scholarship Committee for the purpose of creating or modifying the scholarship application. The committee will select the recipient of the scholarship(s).
2. Recipients of the scholarship must reapply each year to receive additional funding.
3. The scholarship does not have to be offered every year, nor be awarded after being offered, if suitable applicants are not found.
4. Checks will be mailed to the university to be deposited into the student's account.
5. Scholarships will be awarded on a non-discriminatory basis without regard to race, religion, sex, marital status, or disability.
6. Applicants must be accepted to or enrolled in a college or university.
7. Applicants do not have to be a Farm Bureau member.
8. Applicants must be a resident of Washington County or be attending or have attended a Washington County Public School.
9. Applicants must:

 - Include a copy of high school or college transcripts with the application.
 - Attach a copy of acceptance letter to the application.
 - Include two reference letters.
 - Attach a one to two page essay describing your involvement in the agricultural industry and your future plans.
10. **DEADLINE: APRIL 20th**- Application must be **RECEIVED** by the scholarship committee.
