Scholarship Requirements- The recipient must either be a High School Senior or already attending college. The scholarship is for the amount of **\$600** and will be mailed directly to the college. All applicants must have either been a 4-H or FFA member for at least one year or have displayed activity in the agricultural industry. They must also be a resident of Washington County **OR** be attending or have attended a Washington County Public School. The recipient does not have to be studying agriculture as a major just involved in the industry. The applicant must be pursuing an associates or bachelor's degree or a certain trade.

Please Include- A high school or college transcript along with a page describing you, your involvement and accomplishments in agriculture, your future plans and how you intend to help rural communities whether through education, medical, business, agriculture etc. The paper can be in essay or question and answer format.
