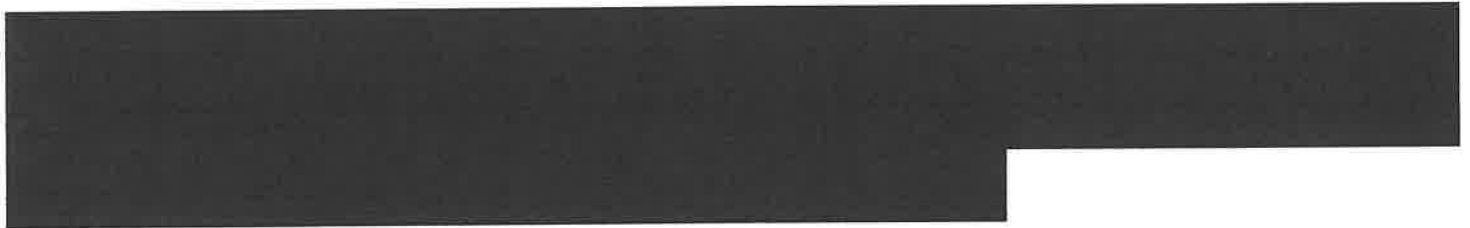

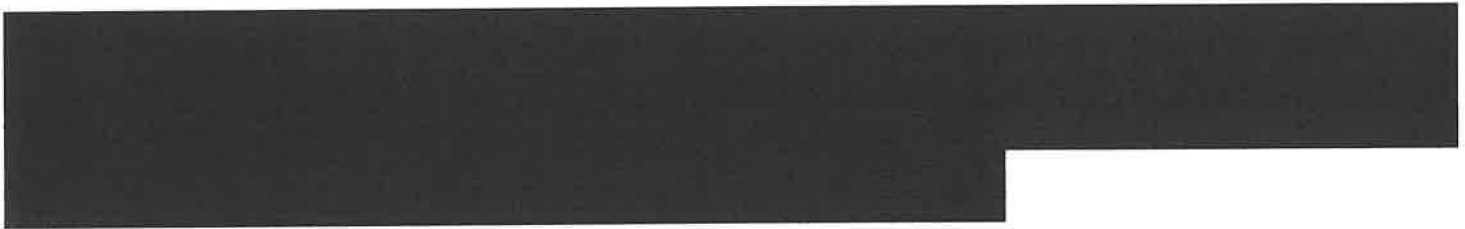

Instructions

RETURN TO GUIDANCE NO LATER THAN FEBRUARY 1ST

The Applicant:

1. Shall be a senior at a Washington County Virginia high school.
2. Shall show evidence of leadership in school activities.
3. Should be an active participant in church activities
4. Shall have shown participation in community service activities – *preferably* a Washington County Community Scholar. Other community activities are encouraged such as boy Scouts/Girl Scouts, 4-H, etc.
5. Will list on one side of 8 ½ “ x 11” paper: school leadership activities, extra-curricular activities, community activities, church activities, honors received, scholastic achievements, or other significant accomplishments.
6. Shall include an original transcript of high school grades, including class rank/class size and test scores, and *preferably* he/she should have at least a 3.5 GPA.
7. Shall include dated, signed and sealed letters of recommendation from at least two but not more than four persons. At least one is to be from a teacher or a guidance counselor, and one must be from someone in the community. Letters should cover the applicant’s ability, work habits, leadership, integrity, character, potential and volunteer activities.
8. Shall write and include an essay, of no more than 500 words, by the applicant giving examples of their leadership involvement in the school and community. Church activities can also be included.
9. The scholarship winner will provide to Black's Fort Chapter all information necessary to send the scholarship to the college the winner will be attending.

Award is made based on merit and if no credible application is received, no scholarship will be awarded. Applications must be received in the high school guidance office on or before February 15th.

BLACK'S FORT DAR LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP

Black's Fort Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution wishes to honor a Washington County senior who has been a leader in their school and community with a scholarship.

Seniors from all Washington County high schools are eligible to compete for the scholarship which will be awarded to the most outstanding applicant from the county.

The scholarship will be paid to the college the student will be attending and will be divided into two equal payments for the two semesters of their Freshman year.

To qualify an applicant:

1. Must be a senior at a Washington County Virginia high school
2. Should have at least a 3.5 GPA (Not absolutely required)
3. Must have shown leadership in their school and community
4. Should be active in church activities
5. Should be a Washington County Community Scholar.

Applicants must:

1. Fill out an application form.
2. Have at least 2 letters of reference – one can be from the school and one must be from someone in the community. Up to 4 letters of reference can be included if the applicant wishes.
3. Write an essay of no more than 500 words, which shall include his/her involvement in community activities with evidence of leadership shown

The deadline for application to be returned to the school guidance office is February 15th. A DAR scholarship committee member will pick up the application from the school guidance office after February 15.

Criteria must be met or no scholarship will be awarded.
