



THE JEFF BYRD “EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS” \$1,000 SCHOLARSHIP

Deadline to apply - April 6, 2018

This prestigious scholarship provides a foundation for high-achieving students to develop and realize their potential for success, while inspiring recipients to reach out through service and mentorship beyond graduation to become leaders and role models in their professions and their communities, while also making a difference and inspiring others in the same way that they have been inspired.

The scholarship was established in 2011 by the Bristol Chamber of Commerce in honor of former Bristol Motor Speedway President and General Manager Jeff Byrd, who passed away in 2010 after a battle with cancer. Byrd, a former Bristol Chamber chair, was extremely involved in the community and was known for his mantra “Exceed Expectations.”

- Must be a graduating senior from one of the following: John Battle High School, Sullivan Central High School, Sullivan East High School, Tennessee High School, Tri-Cities Christian School or Virginia High School.
- Must receive acceptance to one of the following colleges/universities as a first-time freshman: East Tennessee State University, Emory & Henry College, King College, Milligan College, National College, Northeast State Community College or Virginia Highlands Community College.
- Minimum 2.5 GPA
- Must be a U.S. Citizen

- 2 letters of recommendation (1 teacher and 1 person from the community suggested)
