<b>English</b>	4 credits in standard or above
<b>Math</b>	4 credits (Alg.I,II, Geometry, & 1 higher math required) Capstone Math will count toward these requirements as well <b>Bridge math (TN) does not count for TN/VA Scholars. SAILS Math (TN) will count toward the 4<sup>th</sup> Math</b> <b>Caution: Bridge nor SAILS will not be acceptable for NCAA course requirements.</b>
<b>Science</b>	3 credits in lab science <b>Biology and Chemistry required plus 1 other lab science</b> <b>(Physics Preferred)</b>
<b>Social Studies</b>	3credits Must meet state requirements
<b>Personal Finance</b>	.5 credit
<b>Additional Classes</b>	<b>Choose 2 additional classes of your choosing</b>
<b>Foreign language</b>	<b>2 credits in same language (CANNOT OPT OUT)</b>

## Tennessee/Virginia Scholars Requirements

- ★ 4 years of English
- ★ 4 Years of Math (Bridge Math does not count as a 4<sup>th</sup> Math for Tennessee/Virginia Scholars) (Capstone Math will count) (SAILS Math will count)
- ★ 3 Laboratory Sciences (Biology and Chemistry are required as 2 of those sciences)
- ★ 3 Years of Social Studies
- ★ 2 Years of Foreign Language
- ★ 1 Year of Fine Arts
- ★ Personal Finance as required by the State of Tennessee or Virginia
- ★ Physical Education as required by the State of Tennessee or Virginia
- ★ 2 Additional classes of your choice
- ★ No class can count more than once.

### Workforce Development Requirements

- ★ No Out of School Suspension
- ★ Maintain 95% attendance for 4 years (No more than 36 total days missed in 4 years)
- ★ Maintain a C or above average in all classes. If your final class completion grade is a D or F you must retake that class and make at least a C to count that grade for the class.
- ★ Complete 80 hours or more **volunteer service hours to help your community**. These hours must be completed before school or after school and cannot be counted as a grade or for pay. Mission trips can be counted as 8 hours per day you work. Please make sure you keep a log of your hours.
